				The laboratories have inspection rounds twice a year.  In Copenhagen LN and APN have talked about having an inspection round in December.  KBJ: We are located at different addresses. There must be room for flexibility, but we should aim at more alignment in the work assessment work (APV).  It was agreed that the first AMiU meeting in 2019 is held in the beginning of February.
6.	Follow-up on work with action plans	D	All 11:30 – 11:55	MHJ: The doors to the building are locked at 3:30 p.m. Why are the doors locked so early? And is it possible to change the time? MHJ has talked to CAS. CAS states that the doors are open in the 'fix time' and must be locked at the same time all over AAU. It might be possible to postpone the time with half an hour if we can argue that it is necessary with regard to receiving parcels. We still await an explanation from CAS. Also the doors inside the building are locked at 3:30 p.m. CS has reported locking of inside doors, and CAS will change the time where possible.  The Rambøll tool is shut down after 1 January 2019. We will work with the action plans in excel and in Workzone. It will be an item on the agenda for the next meeting.  Escape route plans at Badehusvej: AMS is expected to inspect in week 47.
